LANGTONS Classification

The pinnacle of recognition for Australian wineries and producers, the LANGTONS Classification of Australian Wine is the go-to guide to Australia's most highly sought-after wines, reflecting consumer demand, collectability, and prices fetched at auction.

The new Classification comprises a total of 100 wines across 60 wineries. The wines are given the title of 'Classified', reflecting their demand and performance in the secondary market (at auction). A special designation of '1st Classified' is reserved for a small cohort of wines representing the most desirable wines in Australia that compete with the world's finest. The '1st Classified' name is a homage to the Premier Cru (First Growth) wines that sit atop the 1855 Bordeaux Classification, which was the original inspiration for the LANGTONS Classification.

This new edition shows the biggest change in the history of the LANGTONS Classification with clear trends towards elegance and distinction. Driving this change, the new guard illustrates the trend for Australia's wine scene in an international context where fine wine moves into the realm of luxury.

Old Vine Charter

Barossa contains some of the oldest vineyards in the world – with one planting believed to date back to 1843.

There are 233 hectares of vines planted in Barossa which are more than 100 years old that continue producing fruit to this day. These vines delve deep into multiple layers of soil and speak volumes of the place they are grown. It is generally accepted that these low yielding Old Vines go through the ripening process more effectively generating fruit full of intensity and flavour. Hand pruned and picked these old vineyards yield on average merely 3-5 tonnes per hectare.

In 2009, the Barossa Old Vine Charter was instituted to register vineyards by age, so that older vines could be preserved, retained and promoted. Vineyards are grouped into four categories by age as shown below.

BAROSSA OLD VINE	Equal or greater than 35 years of age
BAROSSA SURVIVOR VINE	Equal or greater than 70 years of age
BAROSSA CENTENARIAN VINE	Equal or greater than 100 years of age
BAROSSA ANCESTOR VINE	Equal or greater than 125 years of age
